The speed limit is 5 mph as soon as you enter the property.



No glass containers - we like to go barefoot here.

Quiet time is 11 p.m. per township rules.

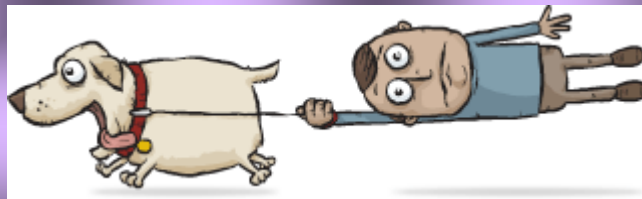
Our farm has a primitive camp with no hookups. Please byo water.

Common sense rules are posted on the bulletin board by big pole barn.

In the event of threatening weather, shelter is provided in the big pole barn.

There are 3 feral cats who live here, run loose & may scratch you if you pick them up.

Dogs are welcome on the farm & must be leashed per state law. Please clean up after your pet so their poop doesn't get in your tent.



Campfires are allowed in fire pits only per state law.

Feel free to stop by the backyard & visit the chickens & watch the ducks play.

Children must be attended to at all times for their safety. There is a pond with depth signs up to 8 feet deep & an in-ground swimming pool for the frogs.



There are 10 acres of woods to walk thru. You may want a spider stick & your feet & legs covered to protect against stinging nettle, wild roses & ticks. Feel free to play in the cool water creek.

The pollinator maze has pink flags that mark the milkweed & arrows marking the perennials so that these plants don't get mowed over.

We love to take care of the land & recycle everything we can. Please help us recycle our trash by using the big trash containers next to the port-a-potties for cans & plastic. We have a dumpster by the big pole barn for everything else except metal & aluminum that scrappers take.



Please do not throw food scraps on the ground as it will attract raccoons, coyote, skunks, opossum & other critters to your site.

Picnic & camping supplies, including ice & firewood, is available at a fair price in the general store up by the house. Fresh produce, garlic bulbs, cacti & barn sale items are also for sale.
